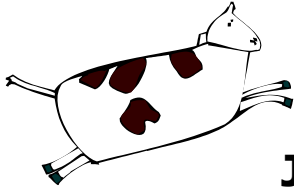

Practical Lambing Course

- How to recognise when to intervene with the lambing ewe
- Lambing techniques including use of ropes
- Care of newborn lambs — tailing, castrating
- How to stomach tube lambs safely
- What to have in a lambing kit
- Recognition and treatment of common diseases in the ewe and in lambs

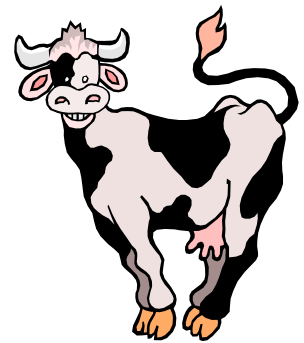




DIY AI Course
